SYNOPSIS

The competition becomes more and more heated as each man thinks she is saving herself for him alone.

The group almost dissolves as the holdout resists, but Gunther, the leader, brings them together in one final orgy.

LIVING & LOVING WITH THE JET SET

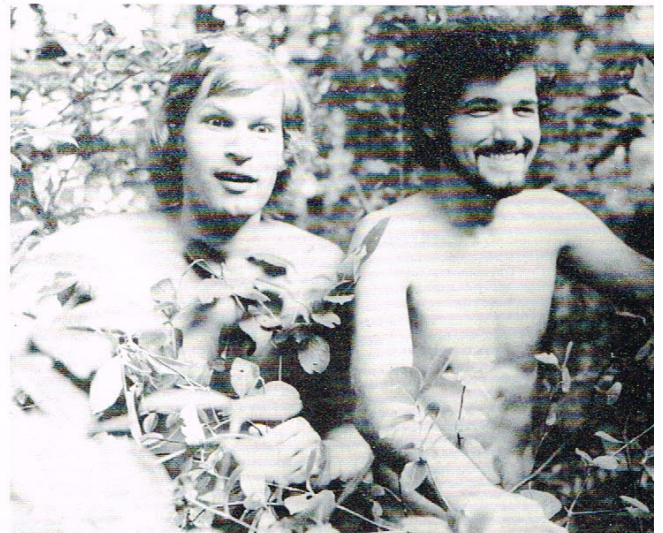
