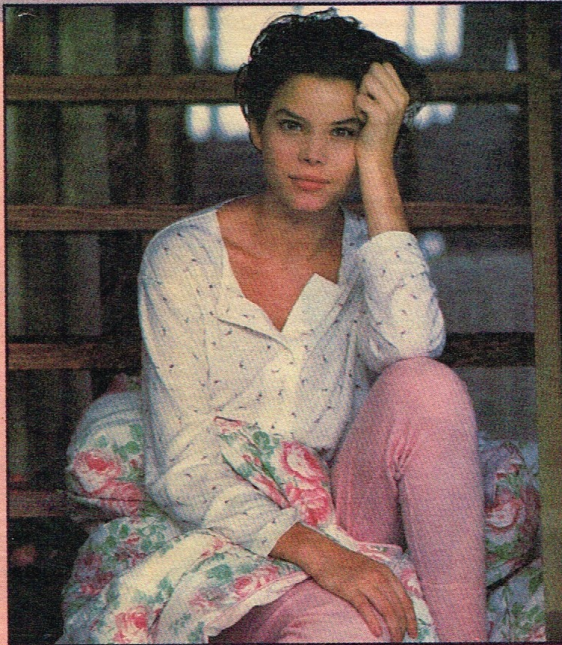

KATHLEEN KINMONT waited eight years to marry Lorenzo Lamas — now she's set to divorce the heartless heartthrob after just eight weeks.

“The honeymoon is over,” a friend of the 22-year-old first-time bride says. “Kathleen told me, ‘Nobody could live with this guy for more than 24 hours. He treats you like the hired help.’”

The friend says Kathleen complains that she thought she was getting Lorenzo to herself. “Instead, he's set her up in a tiny condo and saddled her with taking care of his kids and his dog, which keeps throwing up on the new shag carpet she picked out.

“Kathleen thought she was getting the life of Riley. Instead, Lorenzo's given her life with Rover. She won't stand for it,” the friend says.

“She's already gone off and cried to her mother, but her mother is saying, ‘I told you so.’”

Kathleen's mom is Abby Dalton — who played Lamas' mother on *Falcon Crest*. Abby was against the marriage from the beginning, and stayed away from their Jan. 21 quickie ceremony at a Las Vegas chapel.

The friend says: “Life with Lorenzo is no bed of roses. Kathleen waited all this time, has been in love with him since she was 14, and now she's in turmoil. She doesn't think he's much of a caring husband.

“She realizes now why Lorenzo has been married three other times, engaged to three other women and at one time or another has hit on every beauty in Hollywood.”

The friend says Lamas, 31, has dumped Kathleen into a small two-bedroom condominium in Toluca Lake, Calif., and asked her to play mother to his kids. Lamas has three children — son Alvaro Joshua, 5, and daughter Shane, 3, by his second wife, publicist Michele Smith, and seven-

month-old daughter Paton, from actress Daphne Ashbrook, 23, who Lamas was set to marry last Dec. 18.

“Kathleen says Lamas is cheap,” an insider says. “He keeps bringing his kids over and expects her to sit for them. He thinks he can get out of paying palimony that way.

“Kathleen says she's no baby sitter and wants a child of her own, but she's questioning what she's gotten herself into with this marriage.

“He takes off for work and she doesn't hear from him.”

According to the insider, Lamas doesn't act like he's married. “He wears a wedding ring, but he hasn't changed. He promised her a honeymoon, and he didn't even deliver on that.”

Then there's his dog. “He told Kathleen they'd move into a big house and the dog would be outside,” the insider says. “Now he tells her he's too busy to look for a house.
